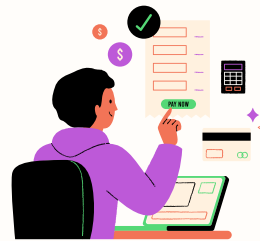


This Year's Big Buy
