Leaf is consulting on its proposed admission arrangements for the academic year 2025/26. The consultation will be open from 18th December 2023 to 29th January 2024. Full draft arrangements for all schools can be read at www.leaftrust.co.uk Paper copies are also available on request.

Leaf proposes to adopt the existing admission arrangements, previously determined by South Gloucestershire County Council, save for a reduction in Published Admission Number (PAN) at The Tynings Primary School, where it is proposed to reduce the PAN from 60 to either 45 or 30. A smaller intake will more accurately reflect the number of applications each year, and will permit all classes to be accommodated in the main school building.

Barnabas Birthday Books


Celebrate your birthday by giving back to the library!
